

PLAYING REGULATION 3.0 - BASKETBALL (BOYS)

1. **SAFETY GUIDELINES:** Each HSSAA Member School shall ensure that the Physical Education Safety Guidelines - Secondary Inter School Module 1999, outlined according to the following Critical Components: EQUIPMENT, CLOTHING / FOOTWEAR, FACILITIES, SPECIAL RULES / INSTRUCTION and SUPERVISION, be adhered to at all times. Specific details on the Critical Components will be provided at the Pre-Season Coaches Meeting.
2. **AGES:** All competitors shall meet the Midget, Junior and Senior age requirements as per Article XI, Section VII of the Constitution.
3. **EVENTS:** There will be competition for a Midget, Junior and Senior Champion. All levels of competition will consist of games played in (4) eight minute quarters.
4. **ELIGIBILITY:** As governed by H.S.S.A.A. Constitution Article XI, Section V.
5. **ENTRIES:** Each of the H.S.S.A.A. Member Schools may enter one team per division. No limit to the number of players dressed for the game.
6. **RULE BOOK:** The C.A.B.A. Rule Book will apply.
7. **OFFICIALS:** The officials will be of the highest caliber. (Inter-Collegiate)
8. **UNIFORMS:** Not specified. (Except as per Section 6 above)
9. **STARTING TIME:** Not specified.
10. **AWARDS:** For each division, there will be:
 - A) A Trophy - for the winning team.
 - B) Medallions - for each member of the winning team.
 - C) Medallions - for each member of the finalist team.
11. **GHAC REPRESENTATION:** The Halton Champion in Senior will advance to the GHAC Championship game. An OFSAA declared "A" or "AA" school may not advance to the GHAC Championship at the "AAA" level unless the said "A" or "AA" school indicates its "AAA" intention before the Halton Playoffs begin.

11. GENERAL REGULATIONS:

PLAYOFF PROCEDURE: HSSAA will run a four division schedule for the following sports:

Fall – Boys Volleyball

Winter- Boys Basketball / Girls Volleyball

Spring – Boys and Girls Soccer, Boys Baseball, Girls Softball

The four divisions will be:

NORTH – Acton, Georgetown, Christ the King, Milton DHS, Bishop Reding, EC Drury, EC Drury School for the Deaf

CENTRAL – Nelson, Robert Bateman, Abby Park, Blakelock, Loyola.

EAST- OTHS, Iroquois Ridge, White Oaks, Holy Trinity, Aquinas, Kings CC

WEST – Aldershot, B.Central, Assumption, MMR, Notre Dame, LB Pearson

C) CO-OPERATIVE MALE-FEMALE SCHEDULES

1. Co-ordinate male-female schedules as much as possible. (e.g. Boys basketball and Girls Volleyball Schedules)

D) TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES When two teams are tied:

1. Record between the two teams
2. If still tied, use point spread between the teams with a maximum of ten points per game.
3. If still tied, a coin toss will determine the higher standing of a game on a neutral court if one team will be eliminated from playoffs.

When three teams are tied:

1. A team that has dominated the other two will receive the highest standing. The remaining teams will revert to the above method.
2. If still tied, the team with the best point spread between the tied teams will receive the highest ranking, the teams revert to the method above. (Max 18 points)

When four teams are tied:

1. Record between the four teams
2. If possible, use point spread to determine final standing. (Max 10 points)
3. If a playoff position is involved, the point spread will be used to determine a 1-4 ranking.(max 10 pts) Two preliminary Playoff games will be played (1vs4 /2vs3). The two remaining teams would be ranked according to the point spread between these two teams.

E) A player ejected from a league or playoff game will be automatically prohibited from dressing for and participating in the next scheduled game. This does not include disqualification by personal fouls.

F) At all H.S.S.A.A. games, effective September 1990, a three copy game sheet must be used with one copy going to the Visiting team, one copy to the Home team and one copy to the Athletic Convenor.
